



## Practicum Video Submission

The purpose of your video submission is to document your ability to effectively manage individual, small group, and whole group lessons. It is not a tool for evaluating or documenting the behavior of children.

Many schools will have policies related to the use of images of children. Be sure to know your own school's policy and follow it. If additional information is needed for parent or administrative guidance, be assured that:

1. We ask for no information that might identify a child or disclose the child's personal information. We may ask you for general information such as age ranges of the groups or individuals.
2. Your submission will not be reposted or shared with any individual outside Seacoast faculty.
3. After your submission link is received and reviewed it will be retained only as long as necessary for our accrediting body to verify the presence of complete documents in your file.

### Submitting:

Due to the size of files they should be saved to your Google Drive and a link submitted via the Submitting Assignments form on our web site. You may restrict permissions for the file so that it can be viewed only by [director.seacoast@gmail.com](mailto:director.seacoast@gmail.com).

In preparing your video, please take a minimum of 15 minutes of your teaching activity at each of four types:

### Content:

- one individual lesson in math
- one individual or small group language lesson
- one small group cultural lesson
- one group meeting or lesson

These may take place on different days. Identify the dates and name of the practicum site in the description when you submit.
